

CITY OF MIDDLETOWN DOG ORDINANCES

Running at large - No person will allow his dog to run at large at any time day or night.

Leashing – All dogs in the City of Middletown, whether or not licensed shall be restrained by a leash while off owner's property.

Barking - No person shall permit their dog to bark or howl at any time, night or day for a period in excess of fifteen (15) minutes.

Feces removal - Any person owning or in charge of any dog which defecates on any common thoroughfare, sidewalk, passageway, play area, park or any place where people congregate or walk or upon a private property without the permission of the owner of said property shall immediately remove all feces deposited by such dog, in a sanitary manner,

License - All dogs owned or harbored in the City of Middletown, being four (4) months or older must be licensed and wearing a license tag. A New York State license can be obtained at the City of Middletown Clerk's Office located at City Hall 16 James St. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required.

City Parks - No dogs shall be permitted in any parks owned by the City of Middletown except in areas specifically designated for such use by the Department Parks & Recreation.
There is one designated dog walk at present at the Fancher Davidge Park for a map please contact animal control.

Number of Dogs - No more than four (4) dogs over the age of four (4) months may be harbored or permitted to remain in any dwelling or lot in the City of Middletown.

CATS

Number of Cats - No more than five (5) cats over the age of four (4) months may be harbored or permitted to remain in any dwelling or lot in the City of Middletown.

FARM ANIMALS

Farm Animals - It shall be unlawful to permit any of the following farm animals to be harbored or allowed to remain in any dwelling or lot in the City of Middletown -
Cattle - Chicken - Duck - Goose - Goat - Horse - Pig
